Definitions

• Transgender:

Of, relating to, or designating a person whose identity does not conform unambiguously to conventional notions of male or female gender roles, but combines or moves between these.

• Cisgender:

An individual's self-perception of their gender matches the sex they were assigned at birth

Transsexual

A person who emotionally and psychologically feels that they belong to the opposite sex.

Crossdresser

A person who wears clothing and other accoutrements commonly associated with the opposite sex within a particular society

• Intersexed

One having both male and female sexual characteristics and organs; at birth an unambiguous assignment of male or female cannot be made. Replaces the pervious term *hermaphrodite* which is no longer used and considered derogatory.

Drag King / Queen

Someone who dresses, and often acts, like a person of the opposite sex, often for the purpose of entertaining.

• Gender Queer

Denoting or relating to a person who does not subscribe to conventional gender distinctions but identifies with neither, both, or a combination of male and female genders.

• Androgynous

Partly male and partly female in appearance; of indeterminate sex.

• 2 Spirited

A person who simultaneously houses both a masculine spirit and a feminine spirit. Typically used in reference to First Nations People.


